Norco College 140th Anniversary

Norco College invites you to take a trip back to June 4, 1983, when the U.S. Navy surplus land became the future site of Norco College in "Navy Property."

RCCD became interested in the navy property and toured it at the instigation of RCCD Trustee DE W. Allen Arrey in early 1983. After viewing the site, the district planned to request Parcel C-2, which was approximately 142 acres for the development of their campus.

In January 1984, RCCD initiated an application with the Department of Education for the parcel to the General Services Administration. To strengthen the application, the college solicited resolutions and letters of support from both groups and individuals. It worked.

On June 4, 1983, the 140th anniversary of Norco land was officially conveyed via private claim deed to RCCD.
