

# Norco College



California Community Colleges are now offering Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT's) to the CSU. These may include Associate in Arts (AAT) or Associate in Science (AST) degrees. These degrees are designed to provide a clear pathway to a CSU major and baccalaureate degree. California Community College students who are awarded an AAT or AST degree are guaranteed admission with junior standing somewhere in the CSU system and given priority admission consideration to their CSU campus or to a program that is deemed similar to their community college major. This priority does not guarantee admission to specific majors or campuses. Students who have been awarded an AAT or AST are able to complete their remaining requirements for the baccalaureate degree within 60 semester or 90 quarter units. All courses in the major must be completed with a grade of "C" (or "P") or better.
