VI. Review and Comment on the District's OER Survey Questions

This survey was not shared/developed with anyone at Norco College. We need to try to get increased involvement from CMAC on a district level with the many sequential processes are not being navigated properly because actions are being taken to implement of XB12 requirements.

Discussion of suggested edits to last year's survey

- Q1: What types of course materials are required for (you check all that apply)
 - ™ Suggestion to add ZTC Print, ZTC Digital, ZTC, NIM, IMC, and OER as answer options.
 - ™ Suggestion to remove Printed textbook(s), Digital textbook(s), Printed textbook that must be purchased/rented, and Digital textbook that must be purchased/rented
 - ™ Suggestion to remove Printed material other than textbooks and Digital material other than textbooks options
- Q2: When selecting required course materials, how important are the following factors in your decision?
 - ™ Suggestion to Add accessibility as an option
- Q3: How satisfied are you with the required course material(s)?
 - ™ Suggestion to Add accessibility as an option
- Q4: How familiar are you with each of the following licensing mechanisms?
 - ™ Suggestion to delete this question because it might scare faculty away from using OER. Using that wording can make people not want to get involved.
 - ™ Instead, ask "Are you familiar with or have you taken the Norco College OER basics course? It would be acceptable for RCC or other colleges to take part in our Norco College OER course."
- Q5: How familiar are you with Open Educational Resources (OER)?
 - ™ Suggestion to keep question as is
 - ™ Suggestion to add follow-up question: How familiar are you with ZTC or LT Choices: Very familiar, Somewhat familiar, Not familiar, News to me, What the heck is that, Not another acronym, Not applicable.
- Q6: How familiar are you with Zero Cost Textbooks (e.g. open stacks)?
- Ran out of time to discuss questions so Adam will be sending survey out to CMAC members to review and suggest edits through Google

Started discussion of how learning is affected by using ZTC. It is possible that data collection may allow us to see differences between using ZTC or traditional materials.

- Sarah suggested to try and connect with Assessment Committee to see if it is possible to even collect this type of data in a meaningful way (show causality)
- It is important to see if faculty are using different methods of teaching OER/ZTC. This would be an important confounding factor
- Free access helps all students have all the necessary texts does not force a student to use them appropriately
- Steven commented that he has had good feedback about the embedded chapters of books in the Canvas modules. With his personal class numbers, it seems like students complete assignments more often than before embedded those chapters
