Institution-Set Standards (ISS) are comprised of two elements: floor performance and stretch goals. The floor performance is the level that marks when the institution is moving into a “danger zone” for a specific outcome area. The methodology involved in setting the floor ISS is by calculating the value of one-half a standard deviation below a 5-year mean. The stretch goals’ methodology is more varied, but usually involves aligning with an established framework (e.g. Vision for Success, Guided Pathways, local goals, etc.). When values fall below the ISS for at least 2 years,
