While mostly working remotely, the College was very active in 2020-2021 with facilities upgrade and reinvestment in our physical plant. Due to the pandemic, our very scarce 2020–2021 general fund purchases were conservative this past year focusing on safety, student success, facility maintenance, and direct expenses related to COVID mitigation. Some examples of funded and completed projects include:

- Transfer Space New Partitions and furnishings
- SSV 212 Flooring and furnishing replacement
- ADA access improvements
- Lighting controller installation
- Outdoor amphitheater study space
- Veterans Resource Center construction

As a result of the efforts by all of us as one team, all 2020-2021 resource allocation decisions followed our prioritization process with an eye towards our core commitments and our strategic planning goals of student transformation, college transformation, and regional transformation. We will continuously assess and measure how our allocation of resources impacts student completion and our learning environment.
