



At California State University (CSU) and University of California (UC)

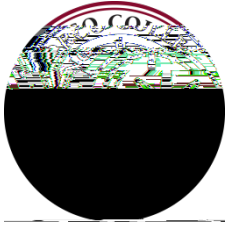
Undergraduate students enrolled at Riverside Community College District may enroll at a CSU or UC campus without formal admissions and without payment of additional State University fees, in a maximum of one course per academic term at a campus of either the CSU or UC system on a space available basis at the discretion of the appropriate campus authorities on both campuses. Enrollments in pre-collegiate courses are excluded.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Completed at least one term at home campus as a matriculated student

Earned a grade point average of 2.0 or higher

Earned a grade point average of 2.0 or higher in the last two semesters of enrollment at home campus



Application for Cross Enrollment

Complete form and submit to the Dean of Student Services Office (second floor of SSV) prior to host college filing period. You must verify admission and filing deadlines with the host college. After home college completes certifications, seek instructor approval at Host College during filing period designated by Host College. Host College will provide registration instructions.
