 - o Tutors need to have an active roletine class, for the times that they are scheduled to be in the class, nost jattending the class as a student
 - o The instructor owns the class space
 - o Tutors are mindful to the instructor's lead
 - o Tutors and faculty discuss what is expected of the tutor's participation and what strategies will be used inside the class
 - o Tutors are not teaching assistants. They do not:
 - f Grade papers
 - f Enforcement of class policy or discipline
 - f Lecture (tutors are not teachersd will not lecture/re-lecture)
 - f Supervise the class in the absence of the instructor
 - f Assist with students with contend type to vered by the instructor

Study Group Best Practices:

- x Scheduled based on studentaiteability survey results
- x Take place outside of class time
- x Held in the LRC Zoom link
- x Tutors assist individual studts with their individual needs
- x Tutors do not independently generate content
- x Faculty may or may not produce materials for Study Groups
 - o Tutors may assist instrums with creating materials
- x Study Groups are open to all students **the**tenrolled in the same course

Helpful tips/suggestions:

- x Add the tutor to your Canvas class(with the ability to post announcements.
- x Allow the tutor to make class announcements and reminder study Groups days/times and encourage students to attend tutoring hours

- o Data from previous terms suggests **that** tutors making nnouncements and reminders increased attendance rates.
- x Discuss with the tutor what kind of suppand access you feel comfortable with the tutor utilizing in the class.
 - o Tutors are trained to be respectful of thstructor's space. Please discuss how they may function in the class and Zoonssiens (if applicable in a way that you prefer.
 - o As the instructor, it is your class. The tutor needs ur permission to perform duties inside the class times, via the pitray sclassroom, Caraxs, and/or Zoom.
- x Allow the tutor to respond to studeinquiries on Pronto if applicable).
 - Discuss what type of student questions feel comfortable with the tutor responding to. This can help build adiof communication between the students and the tutor.

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
